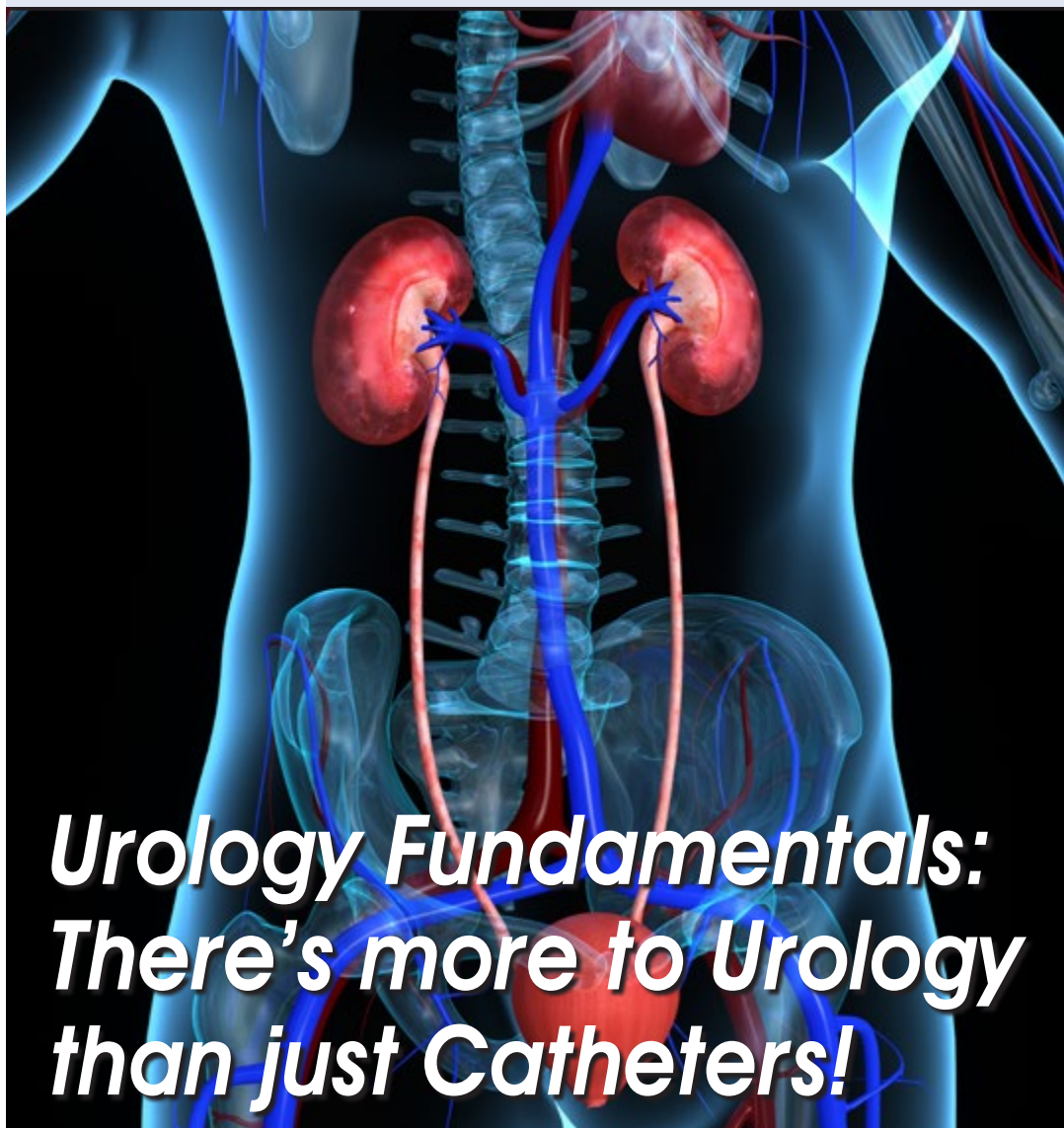

Course Description

Urology Centers of Alabama is offering continuing education through the Medical Association of the State of Alabama. This continuing medical education meeting is designed to provide physicians and other healthcare staff with a practical and timely overview of the important developments in the care of urology patients. The format will be an overview of the disease state and presentation on current standard of care for diagnosis and treatment. A spectrum of urology topics will be discussed. Adequate time after each set of lectures will permit panel discussion, as well as, opportunity for questions and comments from the audience.

Objectives

1. Identify the newest technology in radiation treatments for men diagnosed with prostate cancer. Attendees will be able to answer questions from their patients and help set expectations.
2. Distinguish treatments for female patients and when a referral to a urogynecologist is appropriate.
3. Recognize the role sexual dysfunction and intimacy issues play in the treatment of certain urological/urogynecology issues.
4. List the risks associated with testosterone replacement.
5. Distinguish alternative treatments to urinary tract infections outside antibiotics.
6. Recognize the mechanism of action of the UroLift System for the treatment of symptoms of BPH and who might be a good candidate.
7. Identify, diagnose and treat overactive bladder in men and women.
8. Explain the importance of early PSA screenings and new guidelines.
9. Identify what laboratory studies to order for diagnosis of hematuria and when a referral is appropriate.
10. Describe the pharmacologic profiles of benzodiazepines, opiates and other controlled drugs.
11. Identify the diagnostic criteria for acute and chronic pain, anxiety disorder, insomnia, depression and substance abuse.
12. Discuss beliefs, attitudes and stereotypes about controlled substance prescribing, controlled drug abusers and chemical dependence and consider the therapeutic implications of treatments based upon these beliefs.

Target Audience

This educational activity is designed for physicians who treat and manage patients with urology issues. This includes those who specialize in family medicine, urgent care, internal medicine and OB/GYN. Also encouraged to attend are nurse practitioners, registered nurses, and physician assistants. If interested, allied health professionals and industry representatives are welcome to attend the educational activity.
